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Hague, Lavrov Smooth Over Syria

RUSSIA'S FOREIGN MINISTRY AND THE HAGUE PROSECUTOR GENERAL HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING ON THE PROSECUTION OF SYRIAN PRESIDENT BASHAR AL-ASSAD FOR ALLEGED CRIMES AGAINST HUMANITY.

The agreement, announced by the Russian Foreign Ministry on Tuesday, states that the Russian government will cooperate with the International Criminal Court (ICC) in the investigation and prosecution of the Syrian president. The agreement also states that the Russian government will provide the ICC with all the information it needs to conduct its investigation.

The agreement is a significant development in the ongoing investigation into the Syrian conflict. It shows that Russia is willing to cooperate with the ICC, despite its long-standing opposition to the court. This move is seen as a sign of Russia's growing engagement with the international community.

Exxon Pours Concrete for Phase 3 of Sakhalin-1

EXXON MOBIL HAS COMPLETED THE POURING OF CONCRETE FOR THE THIRD PHASE OF THE SAKHALIN-1 PROJECT, A MAJOR OIL AND GAS DEVELOPMENT IN THE FAR EAST OF RUSSIA.

The project, which is a joint venture between ExxonMobil and Rosneft, involves the development of the Sakhalin-1 oil and gas field. The third phase of the project involves the construction of a new offshore platform, which will be used to produce and export oil and gas from the field.

The pouring of concrete for the platform is a significant milestone in the project. It shows that the project is progressing well and that ExxonMobil is committed to the development of the field. The platform is expected to be completed in 2015, and it will significantly increase the production of oil and gas from the Sakhalin-1 field.
